The Kentwood Community PTSA is awarding scholarships to students from the graduating class of 2010. These scholarships are awarded by the KWPTSA scholarship committee, and are judged on:

1. The expression of ideas in an essay.
2. School and community involvement, honors and recognition
3. Academic record.

Each candidate must be a Kentwood High School student during his/her senior year, must be a graduating senior and must have plans to attend a trade school, junior college, or a four-year college. Winners must use the awarded amount within eighteen months of the date of the award unless there are extenuating circumstances approved by the committee.

Applications are available in the Kentwood High School Counseling Office. Applications must be turned in by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, May 10, 2010 to the same office. Each applicant will be identified by their student ID number only, so the committee will not know the names of the applicants.

The committee will consist of four PTSA members who are not senior parents. The following criteria shall be used to determine the scholarship recipients:

1. 60 points – essay (20 points grammar, 40 points content) on “Which Kentwood Staff member made a difference in your life and how? 150-250 words.
2. 20 points – school and community involvement, honors and recognition
3. 20 points – academic record.

Note: If you have any questions on whether participation in an activity, club, or event should be included, put it down and let the committee evaluate it.
